# Holy Week

Holy Week is the week leading up to Easter. The Easter story is very important to Christians as it reminds them of Jesus' death and celebrates his resurrection. There are four important days during Holy Week: Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.



# How do Christians celebrate Easter?



#### Hot Cross Buns

The cross reminds Christians that Jesus died on the cross.

### <u>Simnel Cake</u>



This is a special fruit cake eaten at Easter. The cake has a layer of marzipan on top and is decorated with marzipan balls. There are 11 balls to symbolise Jesus's disciples, Judas (the 12<sup>th</sup> disciple) is left out because he betrayed Jesus.



#### Painting and decorating eggs

Eggs are given at Easter because they represent new life and because they are the same shape as the rock which was rolled across Jesus's tomb.

# Year F and 1 Vocabulary

<u>Easter</u> – Christian celebration of when Jesus died and came back to life.

<u>**Resurrection**</u> – When Jesus came back to life.

<u>**Crucified**</u> – Put to death on a cross.
