Colour Mixing



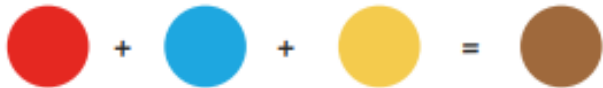
Red and blue make purple.

White and red make pink.



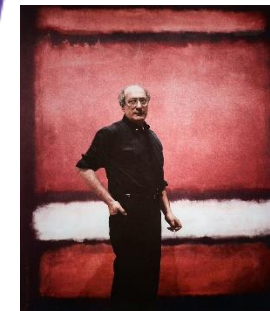
White and black make grey.

Primary Colours - Red, yellow and blue are primary colours. They can't be made by mixing other colours.

Secondary Colours - Orange, green and purple are secondary colours. They are made by mixing two primary colours together.

Tints - These are created by adding white to a colour. This makes a colour lighter.

Shades - These are created by adding black to a colour. This makes a colour darker.
