Vocabulary

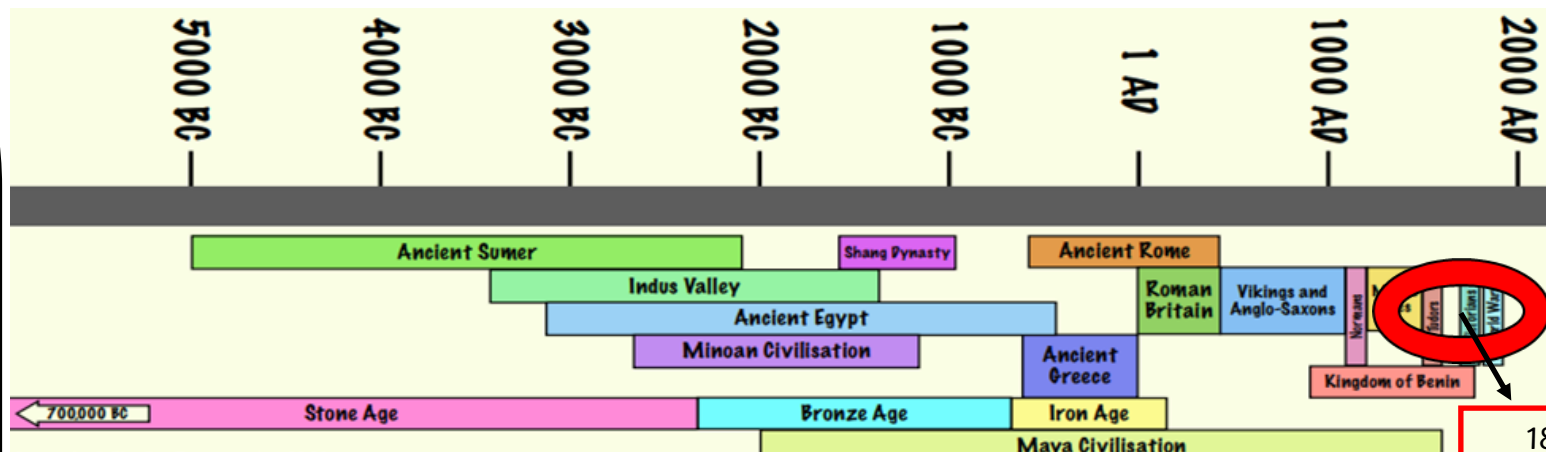
RNLI—Royal National Lifeboat Institute
