



## Topic web—Where in the world are we?

This term, as we begin a new year and welcome our new starters, we will explore our place in the world and our unique corner of Cornwall—Landulph Primary School.

As **mathematicians** we will, embed our knowledge of place value within 10 and progress on to addition and subtraction.

As **geographers** we will, explore where we are in the world using maps. We will then explore our school and create a map of it together. We will use our school map to find our way around.

As **scientists**, we will explore different materials and their characteristics. We will experiment with melting, floating and sinking.

As **readers and writers** we will, be reading and exploring The story 'The Suitcase', by Chris Naylor-Ballesteros. Moving on to The Big Book of the UK, by Imogen Russell Williams. Alongside this, we will continue with daily RWInc. phonics sessions.

As **artists**, we will be creating drawings, focusing on details and using lines and shading. We will use Van Gough as a muse to create detailed drawings of things we have found in nature.

In **PSHE** we will, focusing on the feelings of a Healthy Relationship: Every relationship is different but there are certain feelings we should get from a positive relationship.

As **musicians** we will, explore rhythm, repetition, singing and movement to music.

As **athletes** we will, be exploring how we control our movements; including balancing, travelling and moving and throwing and catching a ball.

As learners of different **faiths**, we will learn about God and what God means to Christians. We will then link this to caring for our world.

As **ICT technicians**, we will be learning about algorithms and how we use them to give a set of instructions.
