KOSHER	NOT KOSHER
Chews its cud and has split hooves Ex: Cows, Sheep, Goats, Deer	Doesn't chew cud and/or doesn't have split hooves Ex: Pigs, Rabbits, Kangaroos
Domesticated species Ex: Chickens, Ducks, Turkey	All scavenger and predatory birds Ex: Vultures, Eagles, Owl
Has both fins and scales Ex: Trout, Tuna, Salmon	Doesn't have both fins and scales Ex: Crustaceans, mollusks, other shellfish
Chuck, rib, shoulder, plate.	Meat and dairy together
Kosher	Not Kosher
	Lamb, sirloin, rump, flank, heel other prepared properly, owner of these could keep the kosher
