



Class 1 - Home Learning Challenges

At Landulph School we believe home learning to be an essential and enjoyable part of a child's education. Home learning encompasses a plethora of activities facilitated by those at home which support and enhance children's learning.

From the learning grid below, you also need to choose a **minimum of two activities** to do over the next few weeks of term, but please feel free to do as many as you want.

The children will be given opportunities to share what they have been doing and celebrate their successes with their class. The emphasis will be on the children sharing their work rather than teacher marking. You might want to send in a photograph, they might record it in writing, make something or they might just talk about what they have done.

Self- Managers	Manage Emotions: Can you draw a picture of something or someone in your life that makes you happy? Effective Participators	Find solutions: Can you plant some seeds and see where they like to live the best? Do they prefer the dark, the light, the dry, the wet, inside or outside?	Get Involved: Can you get a group of people together to play a ball game? Which one will you choose? Will you be using your hands, feet or a bat or club? Share photos of what you choose.
Creative Thinkers	Imagine: In art we are learning about 3D form and sculpture, can you build your own sculpture out of things from home? (It could be out of recycling, clay, lego etc.) Can you spot any sculptures when you're out and about?	
Reflective Learners	Set yourself challenges: Can you sing the oceans and continents songs. Have a look at a world map or globe to see if you can share where we find the continents and oceans. Can you visit and share pictures of a place that is important to you? What are your memories and why is it important? It doesn't have to be religious just special for you.
Enquirers	Explore a question: Can you share equally? Can you divide something fairly to share? What will it be, a pizza, cake, some treats? How can you make sure it is fair?	Reach conclusions: In English we are reading 'The Mousehole cat', https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=m4vL1GFwBuo How do you feel about the 'storm cat', was the storm cat happy or sad?
Team Worker	Build Team Strengths: Can you work together as a family or group of friends to create a sandcastle or sand village? What will you use to decorate it? Will it have a mote or bridge?
