### As linguists we will:

learn to talk about our friends and family in French.

examine colour in depth. Learn about primary, secondary and tertiary colours and find out which colours complement others

### As IT specialists we will:

learn how to research, prepare and present information using green screen

### In PSHE we will:

learn the significance and benefits of thinking positively. Find out about strategies such as mindfulness and gratitude.

### As athletes we will:

learn about the game of Boccia. Practising accurate throwing as well as attacking and defending.

### As musicians we will:

experience different styles of music from across the world.
