Palm Sunday	Jesus arrives in Jerusalem Judas betrays Jesus
Maundy Thursday	The Last Supper and praying at Gethsemane Betrayal and arrest Peter's 3 denials
Good Friday	The trial of Jesus Jesus' crucifixion
Easter Sunday	The empty tomb Jesus' ascension

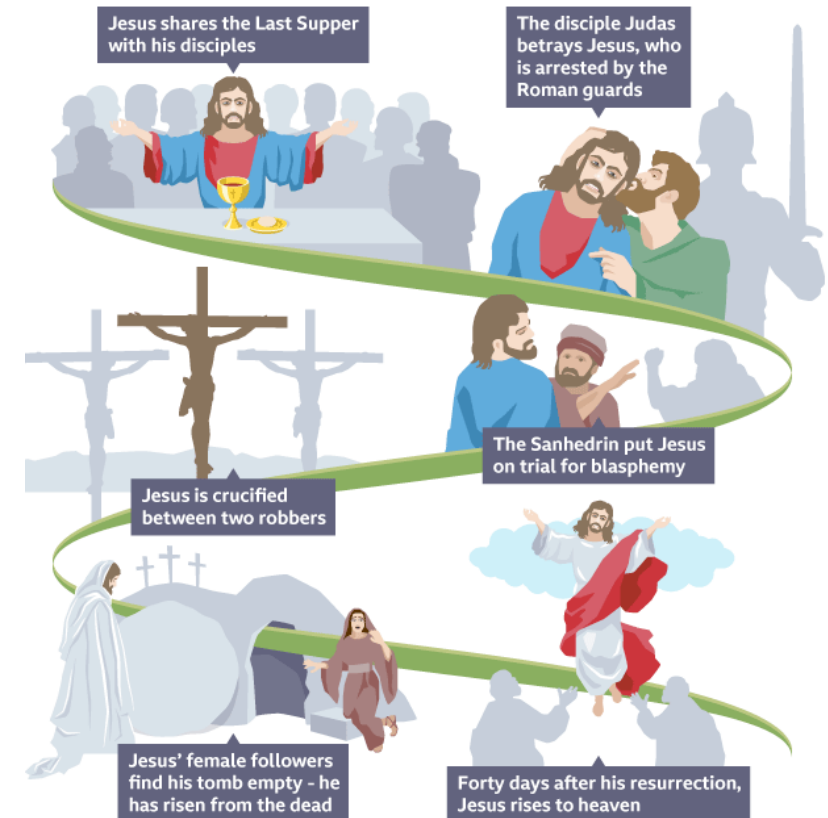
Jesus died to forgive the sins of humans. His death is a reminder to be thankful for that sacrifice.
