From the learning grid below, you need to choose a **minimum of two activities** to do over the half term, but please feel free to do as many as you want.

The emphasis will be on the children sharing their work rather than teacher marking. You might want to send in a photograph, they might record it in writing, make something or they might just talk about what they have done.

Self-Managers	Be organised Organise a mini Olympics for your family or friends. Make a plan, create teams and get the equipment ready. Then have some fun!	Manage Risk Find a safe way to take part in some Olympic style activities like high jump, long jump or hurdles. Take photos for us to see!
Effective Participators	Make Links Find out about local bee/honey farms. Are there any you could visit? Maybe look at some websites to find out some bee facts.	Identify Issues Create a poster promoting the care of bees. How can we help?
Creative Thinkers	Take Creative risks Create bee or flower themed biscuits. We'd love to sample them!	Imagine Imagine you were alive in ancient Greece. Play an imaginative game of Ancient Greeks!
Reflective Learners	Set yourself challenges Badger had a disgusting sandwich...but you can make a delicious one! Create a delicious sandwich and send us a photo!	Share learning Create a presentation however you choose to share your learning about the Greeks. It could be a speech, powerpoint, or explanation text with pictures.
Enquirers	Evaluate evidence Use your maths skill of measuring around the house. Make a table of your findings.	Reach conclusions Explain how the Greeks have changed the world we live in today. Without them what would we be without?
Team Worker	Manage the team Can you work with a family member or friend to plant some pollinator-friendly seeds? It could be in pots or a garden.	Take responsibility Take care of some seeds. What can you grow? Cress? Beans? A sunflower? How can you ensure it is growing well?
