As part of road safety week, we had a visit from A/PS Dan Lewis and PC Martin Cummings. They spoke to the children about how to keep safe when crossing roads, especially if there are no paths or if there are driveways, large lorries and tractors. They reminded them to give the road their full attention and not be



distracted. Also, to stay close to their parents when they are out walking, scooting or cycling.

They also talked to the children about the importance of wearing seatbelts, Hi-Viz clothing and to remind their parents about the 20mph zone leading up to school.

Celebrating our learning...

<u>Class 1</u>

The Foundation children have loved learning about circles, triangles and four sided shapes. They went on a shape hunt to find these shapes around the school, they couldn't believe how many shapes they have found!



<u>Class 2</u>

Even in a shorter week, Class 2 have still fit in a lot! We have used a number of different strategies to solve addition calculations. We are beginning to recognise that different sorts of calculations will require a different method and that we will all have our own preference in which seems most logical. We have been very fortunate this week as we hired a loan box from 'The Box' in Plymouth. It contained a range of artefacts from The Stone Age that we could examine close up. We hypothesised what they were probably used for based on our increasing knowledge of Stone Age life. We have started to learn poems and songs for our Christmas performance which, I'm sure will soon be stuck in everyone's heads at home too!



<u>Class 3</u>

Class 3 have written lots of descriptive passages and have began to plan their final written piece. We have started to find fractions of amounts in Maths and in science have compared geocentric and heliocentric models of the Solar system and explored how light refracts when moving through different materials.
