# A message from Mrs Ball...

This week has been all about reading. It has been lovely being able to spend some time with individual children and listening to them read, it is something I really enjoy doing. I also visited them in their classes for their VIPERS lessons. If you child is in class 2 or 3, you could ask them about the books they have been focusing on in VIPERS and what skills they have had to use.



We know a lot of you already do, but it is so important to set aside some time each day to support your child in their reading journey for example listening to them read their home/school reading book or sharing a bedtime story.

My reading challenge for all you this term, parents, staff and children! Try and read something new: a new author, a new genre or a new series. Send in a photo of your book choice and whether you would recommend it to others.

Have you had a look at your child's knowledge organisers with them?

A <u>knowledge organiser</u> is a set of key facts or information that your child needs to know and be able to recall in order to 'master' a unit of work or topic. At home you can use them to support your child by:

- ⇒ Reading through the Knowledge Organiser with your child get them to explain it to you 'teaching' you helps them to reinforce their learning.
- ⇒ Test them regularly on their understanding of the key vocabulary.
- Read sections out to them, missing out key words or phrases that they have to fill in. Miss out more and more until they are word perfect.
- ⇒ Quizzing
- $\Rightarrow$  Get your child to make a blank Knowledge Organiser and fill in all the gaps without looking.




