Class 1

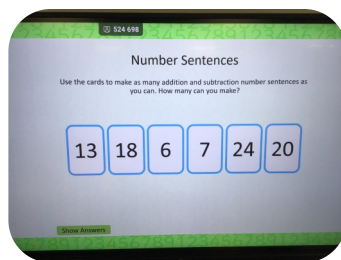
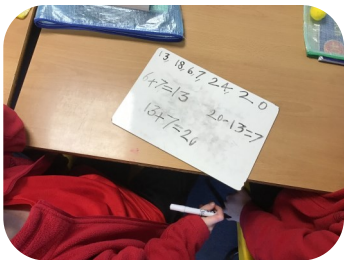
In Class 1 this week, we have been creating texture art inspired by Andy Goldsworthy and nature. We used Google Earth to explore the four countries of the UK and well known sights. We celebrated Number Day today with a monster game, and in English Year 1 excelled themselves with fantastic explanation texts on "how to grow a bean".



Class 2

To celebrate Children's Mental Health week we have been taking time to practice being mindful, and regulating our thoughts and feelings. Some of this has been practicing different types of breathing techniques such as bear breaths and whale breaths!

We have continued our English, getting ready to write our reports next week so we have been working hard on our plans this week! We can't wait to get our brilliant reports written up and published! Every Friday in maths we do a special maths challenge lesson, where we have a problem to solve and we can work with a partner to share ideas and solve it. Last Friday we had to create as many addition and subtraction calculations as we could using only 7 numbers. It was tricky because we couldn't use any other numbers at all, but we worked hard and solved it in the end. In our PSHE learning we are just coming to the end of our money matters unit, so this week Year 3 and 4 worked together to make a tv advert for a specific product. Next week we will be finishing off lots of our topic learning ready for half-term!



Class 3

This week we have started to look at the features of explanation texts with a view to writing our own explanations of hurricanes, earthquakes or volcanoes. In Maths the children have been comparing decimals to fractions. Understanding microorganisms has been the focus of Year 6 science whilst the Year 4s and 5s have continued their work on classifications and life-cycles. We have been exploring the impact of volcanoes in geography, considering the dangers and inconveniences of eruptions to modern life.
