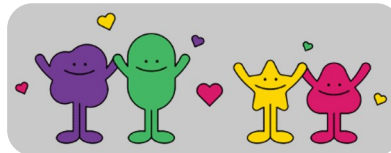


We're proud to be supporting **Neurodiversity Celebration Week 2025!**

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Class 1

In English this week, Class 1 have been writing "A day in Dave's life" to create a diary extract from the story Dogger. In Maths, we completed our addition and subtraction unit which they all did really well with. To celebrate Science week, we created a lava lamp which was bubbly fun! The Pixies explored their emotions in PSHE and in History, we made a timeline to see the changes in toys over time.



Class 2

Class 2 have had another busy week this week. In maths we have begun our new fractions unit, in English we have been writing some lovely character descriptions and in the afternoons we have done a LOT of science! We started on Monday with planting some cress seeds, and they are already coming along quite nicely! Then on Wednesday we had brilliant fun with some felt tips, a cotton pad and a bowl of milk...we made rainbow milk (well, kind of!) We are really trying to pick up the pace on Times Tables Rockstars now; the children are becoming more self sufficient at logging in and accessing the games, so a request please to get your child logged in to a device to practice their times tables and spellings. This is a critical age to get them nailed, so if you need support please see Ms Hawker!



Class 3

This week, Class 3 has been engaged in a wide range of exciting learning activities!

In English, the children wrote descriptive diaries recounting a tour of Athens. They worked hard to capture a character's emotions and thoughts, bringing their writing to life with powerful description and detail.

Our Maths lessons explored key number skills. Year 4 focused on multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100, while Years 5 and 6 tackled equivalent fractions, decimals, and percentages. They also practised finding percentages of amounts, applying their knowledge to real-life scenarios.

In Science, we explored evolution through a creative challenge. The children designed multiple generations of paper aeroplanes, testing and refining their designs to see if each version improved—though, as we discovered, evolution doesn't always lead to success!

During DT, the class investigated catapult designs, discussing how different structures and mechanisms can improve power and accuracy.

In PE, we developed our gymnastics skills by exploring symmetry in rolls and balances. The children worked brilliantly in pairs to create sequences that showcased control and precision.

Our History lessons focused on the political landscape of Ancient Grecian city-states. The children learned about the rule of Oligarchs and Tyrants and how these systems paved the way for the development of democracy.

Finally, in Computing, the class used Scratch to create impressive repeated shape patterns, combining coding skills with artistic creativity.

Well done, Class 3, for another fantastic week of learning! Keep up the great work!

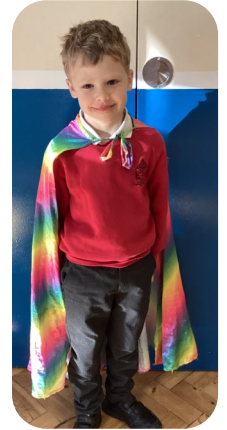

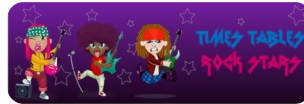

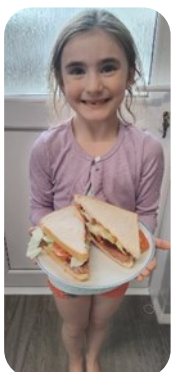
