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### Class 1

On Tuesday, Wild Tribe was a great experience where we focused on looking after our school and did a litter pick. We also wrote our own riddles this week and shared them with the class - we have really enjoyed riddling. In History we found out what kind of toys children played with in Victorian times and we ended the week with some measuring and comparing our height from September to now.



### Class 2

At the end of last week we began a science investigation in which we put sticks of celery in coloured water to see if the water is transported up the stem. At first nothing seemed to happen, so we left them over the weekend...

By Monday morning we discovered that the colour had travelled up the stem of the celery and had made the holes on the top coloured like the water! So water really does travel up plants through the stem! We have started a new topic in maths, measuring mass and capacity so we used our maths lesson on Thursday to compare masses and measure things in grams. In English for the next few days we are looking at Haikus (y2) and Limericks (y3) so by the end of next week we should have some perfect poetry for you!



### Class 3

This week class 3 have been continuing to explore and use figurative language in creating descriptive paragraphs ready to be evolved into poems. Measures of shapes have been the main focus in maths with the children learning how to calculate the perimeter and areas of a variety of shapes. In History, the children have learned about the mythical Trojan war and how Homer penned this as the epic poem 'The Iliad'. We have continued to explore progressive ideas of Humanism in RE and in PSHE we have learned about harmful substances and how they may be encountered throughout life. The Year 5s had a great trip to Liskeard Fire Station on Wednesday where they learned important life skills like water safety, electrical fire safety, CPR and being safe near the railway.

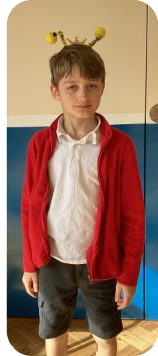
