



Topic web—How can we help plants to thrive?

This term, we will be looking at what different plants need to survive and the impact humans have on plant life around the world.

As mathematicians, we will all be learning about shape, then Year 2 will progress on to position and direction, while Year 3 will learn about perimeter.

As historians, we are going to be learning about Ancient Rome. In this topic we will learn about how the Roman empire developed as well as some Roman gods and myths.

As learners of different faiths, Year 2 will be starting a topic about why Easter matters to Christians while Year 3 will be learning about the festivals of Muslim believers.

As readers we are going to be reading *The Worst Witch* by Jill Murphy. As writers, we will be using inspiration from the story *The boy who grew dragons* to write narrative, and in the final couple of weeks we will be reading and practising poetry.

As scientists, we will be learning about plants. Year 2 will be learning about parts of plants and how they grow, while Year 3 will be learning about the function of plants and the effect humans have on plant populations.

In PSHE, we will be Thinking Positive! This is a lovely topic of thinking about who we are, what makes us special and how we can be our best selves.

As athletes, we will be working with Go Active on Dance on Mondays, then we will have Wild Tribe on Thursdays.

As artists we will be learning about colour; how it is made, how colours can be used in different ways and how colour is used in the wider world for effect.

As musicians, we will be following the unit Zootime. It uses a main song of Zootime by Joanna Mangona, then we listen to other similar songs like Kingston Town by UB40 and Shine by ASWAD.
