



Class 2 - Home Learning Challenges

At Landulph School we believe home learning to be an essential and enjoyable part of a child’s education. Home learning encompasses a plethora of activities facilitated by those at home which support and enhance children’s learning.

From the learning grid below, you need to choose a **minimum of two activities** to do over the half term, but please feel free to do as many as you want.

The children will be given opportunities to share what they have been doing and celebrate their successes with their class. The emphasis will be on the children sharing their work rather than teacher marking. You might want to send in a photograph, they might record it in writing, make something or they might just talk about what they have done.

Self-Managers	Manage risk Make a Roman shield and/or helmet. Choose your materials carefully!	Be Organised Make a plant observation diary about a plant you have grown or is growing in your environment. How does it change as it grows?
Effective Participants	Get involved Grow a bean in a jar or pot and monitor its growth. Could you compare 2 different locations to see which is better?	Persuade Others Create a powerpoint presentation about the importance of protecting plant life. Do we really need plants?
Creative Thinkers	Make links Use our shapes learning to make nets, and 3D shapes. You could decorate them to show our learning about other things too!	Imagine Create a Roman villa using materials you have at home.
Reflective Learners	Set yourself challenges Find out about the Roman gods. Which ones are your favourite and why?	Share learning Write a letter as if you’re a Roman child to explain what life is like in the Roman Empire.
Enquirers	Evaluate evidence Did the Romans make a difference to the world? Present your thoughts in written or digital form.	Explore a Question. Find out about deforestation around the world. What is it and what is the impact of it?
Team Worker	Build Team Strengths Go on a team plant/flower/tree hunt with your family or friends. Let us know what you identified!	Manage the Team Gather a team to re-enact the Roman army tactics!
