



Class 1 - Home Learning Challenges

At Landulph School we believe home learning to be an essential and enjoyable part of a child’s education. Home learning encompasses a plethora of activities facilitated by those at home which support and enhance children’s learning.

We are excited to explore the question of ‘Where in the world do plants grow?’ and learn about plants that grown in different environments all around the world, we are sure the children will embrace all aspects of this topic.

From the learning grid below, you need to choose a **minimum of two activities** to do over the next term, but please feel free to do as many as you want. The children will be given opportunities to share what they have been doing and celebrate their successes with their class. The emphasis will be on the children sharing their work rather than teacher marking. You might want to send in a photograph, they might record it in writing, make something or they might just talk about what they have done.

Creative Thinkers	Imagine: We’re reading ‘Grandad’s Island’ in English where they travel to a tropical island. Can you paint/create a magical land? How would you get there, by boat or aeroplane, maybe a hot air balloon!	
Reflective Learners	Set yourself challenges: Can you make a plant that grows in the rainforest out of... Lego, cake, recycled materials, natural materials, art materials, play doh for example	Share Learning: Can you take a photo of yourself enjoying a book with your Grandad (or Grandma) inspired by our new book ‘Grandad’s Island’?
Enquirers	Explore a question: Create a fact file about Brazil – it might include information about the animals, plants, climate etc.	Reach conclusion: Each week can you set yourself a challenge to go on spelling shed and practise your spellings, how many points can you earn each week?
Team Worker	Build Team Strengths: In science this term is all about being healthy, can you do a team sport as a family? It could be anything from cricket to a homemade obstacle course.
