



## Topic web—Where in the world do plants grow?

This half term, our topic work will focus on where in the world that different plants grow, this will be explored mostly in geography where we will adventure around the world. Alongside this, we will be aiming high in PSHE and we will be enjoying our new story 'Grandad's Island' in our Literacy work.

As **mathematicians**, we will be developing our knowledge of multiplication and division, by learning to counts in 2's, 10's and 5's. We will be exploring fractions and begin to understand half and quarters.

As **geographers**, we will locate the continents and oceans of the world. We will then compare the climate and landscapes of Brazil to that of the UK, whilst also focusing on human and physical features.

As **scientists**, we will identify and explore the importance of exercise, eating a variety of different types of food for humans and how hygiene plays an important part in keeping us healthy.

As **readers and writers**, we will be reading and exploring the story 'Grandad's Island', by Benji Davis. We will then move on to a non-fiction focus, 'The extraordinary gardener' by Sam Boughton later in the term. Alongside this, we will continue with daily RWInc. phonics sessions.

As **designers** this term we will be focussing on creating moving pictures using sliders, levers or pivots to make our picture move.

In **PSHE**, we will be focusing on aiming high. We will be beginning to understand what our star qualities are as individuals and what jobs would suit these qualities. We will also look at setting our own goals and what it will take to achieve them.

As **musicians** we will, learn nursery rhymes and action songs. We will develop our listening and performance skills.

As **ICT technicians**, we will be exploring making music through using programmes such as scratch' and 'GarageBand', we will make exciting rhythms that repeat.

As learners of different **faiths**, the Pixies will explore the things that they find puzzling and interesting about the world. The Pirans will find out about special objects and beliefs of Jewish people.

As **athletes**, we will developing our striking and fielding skills and using them in small game situations.
