| Enquirers | Stay objective Design a healthy packed lunch. Label the contents and explain why you have chosen them. | Explore a question Make a comic strip storyboard to show the journey of food as it is being digested. |
| Team Worker | Build the team Create a healthy meal with your family. Send us a photo! | Manage the team Have a family Greek food tasting like feta cheese, tzatziki, pitta or olives. Send us photos! Maybe write a review! |
